

Norwood High School Graduation Credit Requirements

26 credits are required for graduation

Language Arts	4 credits
Foreign Language	1 credit
Social Studies	3 credits
Mathematics	3 credits
Science	3 credits
Vocational/Technical Ed	2 credits
Physical Education	2 credits
Fine Arts	1 credit
Core Subject Total	19 credits
Electives	7 credits
Total credits	26 credits

- A foreign language may be required at some colleges and universities
- Athletics may account for no more than one credit hour of physical education credit
- Math classes used for meeting mastery criteria will be algebra I, geometry, algebra 2
- Students identified as needing extra help what will also be scheduled a lab time that will cover the same material however only one that credit will be awarded in the lab will count as an elective credit to receive the selective credit students must pass the original math class
- High school elective credit will be granted for students receiving a C or better in eighth grade algebra one. A student receiving this credit will still be required to take three math course which will include geometry and algebra 2

Course Sequence Required

Language arts	English 1, English 2, English 3, English 4
Social Studies	Geography or World History, American History, Civics/Economics
Mathematics	Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2
Science	Earth Science, Biology, Chemistry or Physics or Physical Science as the 3rd required course.
