### **OP and School Based Therapist - Located in Norwood and Telluride, Colorado**

Utilizes a variety of treatment approaches to work with a diverse student population. Services to include individual, but are not limited to, group and family therapy, social emotional group activities, skills groups, behavioral supports, crisis management, care coordination and consultation.

- Full-Time (3 days in Norwood and Telluride Schools, 2 days OP therapy)
- Delivers and documents individual, group, family therapy, crisis intervention and case management services to clients designated by the Center. These services may be delivered in the office or within the community.
- Meets the Center's standard for: Client Care hours, Missed Appointments: i.e. DNS, CBT, CBC, Services Plans, Completion of All Documentation
- May deliver person centered, culturally sensitive evaluations, trauma informed services as defined by position. These services may be delivered in various locations.
- Works with client and their systems to identify treatment goals and objectives.
- Collaborates with NSCBHC and Northside Elementary School staff on care of clients
- Maintains professional licensure and certifications as required for the program
- Maintains client charts/documentation according to the standards outlined in the record keeping procedures, administrative procedures, and quality assurance procedures of the Center (DAP notes, CCARs, Service Plans, Diagnosis, etc).
- Attends staff meetings, in-service meetings and peer reviews, supervision sessions, and other meetings as requested/required
- Responsible for processing referrals and scheduling client services
- Masters level degree in one of the recognized mental health professions
- Fluency in Spanish preferred
- Experience in a school based program preferred
- Training in conducting diagnostic evaluation to establish differential diagnosis and treatment plans
- Colorado State License or License eligible
- Critical and independent thinking skills required
- Excellent communication, computer and writing skills a must
- Hiring range: \$40,000 - \$60,000, depending on licensure, certification and relevant experience
